

**REPORT OF THE ONE-DAY CITIZENS' ENGAGEMENT ON THE 2023 BUDGET
HELD AT NIKE LAKE RESORT HOTEL, ENUGU ON THE 30TH OF NOVEMBER,
2022.**

The Enugu state government under the leadership of His Excellency, Rt. Hon. Dr. Ifeanyi Lawrence Ugwuanyi, con has on Wednesday demonstrated his ardent belief in inclusive and responsive governance as it holds the last Citizens Engagement through the Ministry of Budget and Planning at Nike Lake Resort, Enugu.

The event started with the arrival and registration of participants at about 10.00am.

Opening Remarks:

(a). The Governor of Enugu State

In an opening remark, His Excellency, the Citizens' friendly Governor, who was ably represented by the Hon. Commissioner for Finance and Economic Development, Mrs. Adaonah Kene-Uyanwunne revealed that in adherence to the core value agenda of his administration; Governor Ugwuanyi has upheld a responsive-responsible governance which encourages accountability and transparency to the people; hence the core essence of Citizens' Engagement is to get the people involved in governance especially in budget process and performance.

Gov. Ugwuanyi stated that Citizens' Engagement can be likened to "Nzuko Umunna" because it is a gathering where all participants can freely interact and also vent their anger as the case may be without fear. He noted that although this year's Citizens' Engagement is significant because it is the last fiscal year budget that will be executed by his administration; the Citizens' should be rest assured that their priority needs will be incorporated into the budget. He further thanked the people whose faces he noted have remained consistent over the years in all the previous Citizens' Engagement adding that it is a proof that they have embraced governance.

(b). Honourable Commissioner, Ministry of Budget and Planning:

Also, in a welcome address, the Hon. Commissioner for Budget and Planning, David O. Ugwunta, Ph.D., AIF, HCIB commended His Excellency Rt. Hon. Dr. Ifeanyi Lawrence Ugwuanyi con, for remaining committed to fiscal transparency and inclusive-responsive governance since inception of his administration. He recalled that even before the State Fiscal Transparency, Accountability

and Sustainability (SFTAS) Programme which came up with certain Disbursement Link Indicators (DLIs) in 2018 Citizens Engagement inclusive; this administration had since 2015 offered citizens who are the beneficiaries of all government policies and programmes the opportunity to interact and make inputs in the designing of the State Government programmes and policies. The SFTAS programme has a duration of 4 years with December, 2022 as the programme end date while the Performance for Result (PforR) covered the fiscal performance of States for four years (2018 – 2021). Thus, the 2022 Citizens' Engagement on year 2023 Budget is the 1st engagement after the end of the SFTAS PforR. As such, the Governor has ensured the sustainability of the reforms introduced by SFTAS.

Dr. Ugwunta further noted that the essence of the event was in two folds (1) to present the Citizens' Accountability Report (CAR) on the implementation of the 2021 Budget of Recovery and Continued Growth prepared from the 2021 Audited Financial Statements in collaboration with the Civil Society Organisations, and (2) to create room as usual for the Citizens to make elaborate input in the 2023 budget. He however emphasized that the 2023 budget is a transition budget as such, Citizens are to make inputs prioritizing ongoing projects in their communities and localities for the purpose of completing them before the consideration of new projects.

(c). Citizens' Accountability Report:

During the presentation of the 2021 Citizens Accountability Report (CAR) done by a Deputy Director and Head of Budget Department, Ministry of Budget and Planning, Mrs. Clara N. Ezech and the Co-Chairman, Open Government Partnership representing Civil Society Organisation, Barr. Cromwell Chibuzor; it was noted that the audited financial statement of Enugu state which was produced by the Accountant General of the State is summarized in the 2021 CAR in a format that every Enugu Citizen can comprehend. They noted that from the report, the State Government within the financial year had aggregate expenditure of N112.5 billion. Some of the Citizens' nominated projects implemented in 2021 include: the reconstruction and rehabilitation of public buildings including schools and hospitals across the State; construction of flyover bridge at T-Junction, Nike Lake Road, Enugu East Local Government; completion of Nike Lake-Harmony Junction; rehabilitation of Ngwo/ 9th Mile Water Scheme and Network reticulation; rehabilitation of Urban and Rural roads among others.

Citizens' Engagement:

At the course of the event, the participants were given opportunity to make inputs that will reflect in the 2023 Budget. Some of these inputs are:

1. I thank the State government led by His Excellency, Rt. Hon. Dr. Ifeanyi Lawrence Ugwuanyi con for all he has done so far since inception into office. However, I appeal that majors road that lead to Amechi Village right behind Emenite and another leading to Orie Market by Proda should be constructed. (*Mrs. Augustina Nnamani, Ada Di Iche 08147652489*).
2. Government should invest heavily on ICT especially in the creation of standard State government website and permanent handles. (*Mr. Jideofor Jude Chijioke, Ezeagu Youth 08164641468*).
3. The rice processing factory being built at Ezinesi Oduma has been abandoned due to lack of fund. The State government should please help us look into it. (*HRH Igwe Daniel O. Njoku, Diji 1 of Ezinesi Oduma, Aninri L.G.A, 08033128978*).
4. There is need to resuscitate some Community Development Projects and also boost the marching funding especially for Community Social Development Projects and Rural Electrification Board to enhance development in rural areas. (*Ifeoma Ogbu, PRO Ministry of Rural Development 08038807709*).
5. I appreciate His Excellency for good governance in Enugu State. I wish to remind to the State government to complete the Udenu ring road and the grading of all rural roads in Udenu. Thanks. (*Mr. Abah Patrick O., Coordinator Udenu PGs, 08088037757*).
6. There is need to improve the Internally Generated Revenue as FAAC allocation is already being threatened with the zero or no remittance from NNPC to CBN. The internal roads around Agbani Road should be looked into for repairs so that Agbani gridlock can be reduced. Also, Trans-Ekulu traffic is worth looking into as alternative route can be fixed

to reduce the stress of citizens. The clearance of Dustbins by ESWAMA should also be looking into as several axis for instance One-Day road are usually filled with dirt. (*Mrs. Sonia Ebere Okonkwo, OGP Member, 08063311266*).

7. I thank the Governor for fixing the dilapidated Nkalagu Eha-Amufu road up to Federal College of Education and earth road from the College to Ikem. However due to heavy trucks from the North regularly plying that route to Abakiliki, Imo and Abia, the road is totally damaged. I plead that the State government comes to our rescue. Also, the State government should beef up security in Eha Amufu to curtail the attacks of Fulani herdsmen against farmers which if not done will stifle farming activities thereby leading to serious food scarcity and hunger. (*HRH Igwe Engr. Samuel Ogbodo, Eha Amufu Autonomous Community, Isi-Uzo L.G.A, 07031319748*).
8. I appeal to the State government to provide grant to people working in private sectors especially the private school teachers who are in some cases not well paid. I equally suggest that more youths be enrolled into ICT (*Ofido Emelia I. Enugu State Female Comrades 09060037134*).
9. I propose that the State government creates more skill acquisition hub. Just like the Tech hub, there should be hubs for Agriculture, Fabrication, Auto repairs etc. this will help to consistently empower the youths which will in turn reduce unemployment rate in the State. (*Gabriel U. Odi, Speaker National Youth Assembly of Nigeria, Enugu State, 08035458046*).
10. I plead with the State government to ensure rural electrification in Akpado Umulumgbe Udi L.G.A. Also, low cost housing should be made available for Artisans in Nsukka and Enugu Town. Secondly, more youths should be included in community policing this will help reduce crime in the State. (*Moses Jonathan, Nsukka General Assembly 09022369779*).
11. I plead with the State government to look into the once approved Edem-Nrobo-Abbi road, Uzo-uwani L.G.A. (*Dr. Goodness Nwabueze Enugu State Female Comrades Youth 07081625548*).
12. The Enugu State Budget should make provision for Agricultural Land Development. I and my Community (Ekoh) had provided about two thousand hectares of land for Agricultural use but nothing has been done on it by IFAD and NEPAD simply because there is no budget for such project (*Mr. Mark Ogbonna, Coordinator PG Aninri, L.G.A 07035112926*).

13. I appeal to the State government to reconsider the construction of Agu-Idume Bridge across Ogbafun River in Amagunze, Nkanu East LGA as it was included in the 2022 budget but till now nothing has been done. (*Chief Hycinth Obisi, Chairman Agu-Edume Amagunze Nkanu L.G.A, 08021107845*).
14. The State government should look into Nsukka-Igboeze North -Ette road and Alor-Uno-Okutu road. (*Roy Ekwueme, President Nsukka Youth Assembly 07017001722*).
15. Enugu State government should enforce its commitment made in September 2020 to end open defecation by 2025 in line with global targets set by United Nations. There is also need for the State government to go beyond water provision to provide for satisfaction and hygiene as component of WASH (*Enwetum Ogechukwu U. (Esq.), Executive Director, Divine Era Development and Social Rights Initiatives (CSO) Member, State Steering Committee, OGP. 08038726200*).
16. The roads from Eso bus stop through Emeka Ebula-Ikirike road connecting One-day through Mount-Meniru Street should be captured in the 2023 budget. (*Comr. Ike Austin Izuchukwu, Agbaja Youths General Assembly 08039193656*).
17. I appreciate the State government for the great work done in IMT. However we pray the State government to look into the dilapidated academic blocks in the school like the Food Technology Department, Electrical Engineering Department, Science Laboratory Tech. (*Prof. A. U Nweze, FCA, FCIT, Ph.D., Rector, IMT.*)
18. I plead with the State government to include the renovation of dilapidated primary schools in the rural areas of the State in the 2023 budget. (*Ozoihu Chimma Jane, Ada Di Iche 08034643232*).
19. I suggest that a production industry be sited at Nsukka to take youths out from street. Also, Opi-9th Mile road should be rehabilitated and a flyover constructed at Opi Junction to ease petrol tankers movement. SUMAS at Igbo-Eno should be equipped and made functional. Additionally, rural roads in Nsukka Town- Nguru, Nru and Ihe-Owerre should be opened up to ease transportation of goods to the Town. (*Onyekachi Callistus Omeje, Nsukka Youths General Assembly 07066093565*).
20. I appeal to the State government to capture the completion of the Akpakwume, Ezi-Nze, Ibute-Nze and the Eke-Ebe- Egede-Atta - Akpakwume-Nze road into the 2023 budget as

- only 1km of the road was done in 2019 leaving above 10km undone. (*Charles Chukwuemeka Chibuoke, Chairman Ezedike Football Association 08060582766*).
21. The State government should see to the asphaltting the completed earth road linking Ngwoo-Asaa, Imeama and Nsude Communities. Secondly, a Law should be enacted to make Enugu State Town Union a Ministry so as to enable PGs function as 4tier government in their respective communities. (*Hon. Isaac U. Onyia, Enugu State Association of Town Unions 08037217160*).
 22. The State government should mandate local government to invest in youth empowerment programmers. (*Ebube Nebo, Agbaja Youth General Assembly 08035696810*).
 23. The road connecting Igbo-Eze South and Akpanja part of Kogi state and Ibagwa-Itchi-Unadu-Alor-Agu needs the State government's attention (*Ohagwu Anthony C, PG Coordinator, Igbo-Eze South, L.G.A 08035453777*).
 24. The State government should increase the allocation to Tech Hubs/Youth innovative centers; make provision for ambulances for Primary Health Centers in all the 17 LGAs; employ more Doctors, midwives and Healthcare workers in all the Primary Healthcare Centers in Enugu State and rehabilitate all Urban Street roads (*Dr. Daniel O. Ugwu, Connected Development 08065671192*).
 25. The State government should partner with the Federal government to complete the water reservoir and treatment plant at Obimo and also put measures in place to reticulate this water from the water treatment plant to Nsukka urban. (*Sir, Celestine Ozor, Coordinator Uzo-Uwani, PG 08038871210*).
 26. More detailed attention should be paid to youths who engage in sporting activities in the State (*Prince-will Ugwu, National Youth Council of Nigeria. 08131262493*).
 27. Water supply to Enugu indigenes and renovation of all community schools should be made top priority in 2023 budget. (*Chukwuma Okenwa LEAD Network Africa, 07030083310*).
 28. There is need to urgently complete the upgrade of Special Science School in Ihe, Awgu LGA. Also, the Awgu Games Village needs the State government's attention. (*Chief Udeani P.K. PG Coordinator, Awgu L.G.A. 08063844573*).
 29. The State government should make budgetary allocation to sports development to enable the State contingents participate in National Sports Festival like other States. (*Izuchukwu Epueke, Solid FM*).

30. The construction of Ida-Ajuona Obukpa-Obige Obukpa, Ogbagu Obukpa to Ibagwa-Ani roads should be put into consideration in 2023 (*Barr. R.S.N Ezeh Obige Obukpa 08039513428*).


The Honourable Commissioner, Dr. Ugwunta responded to some of the issues raised by the participants that needed immediate clarification. The event ended at about 1.30pm.



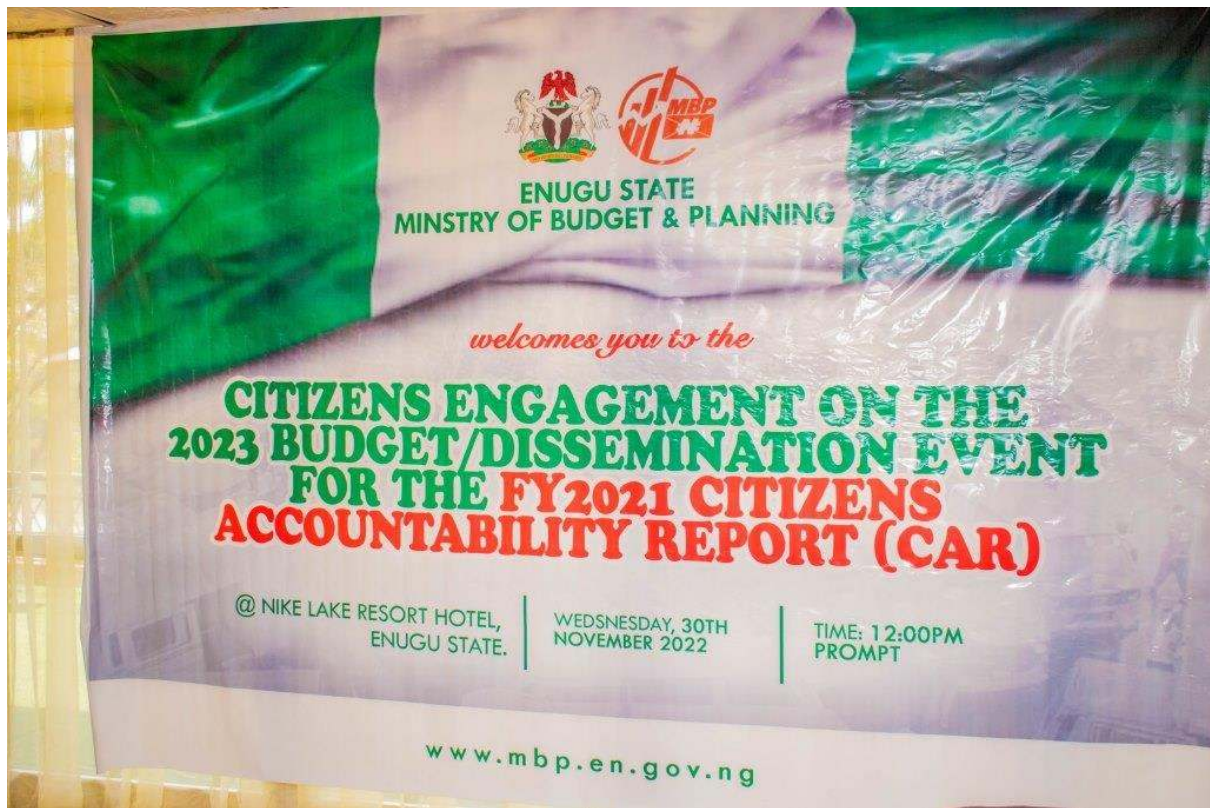
