## ENUGU STATE GOVERNMENT HOLDS CITIZENS ENGAGEMENT ON 2025 BUDGET PREPARATION AND DISSEMINATION OF 2023 CITIZENS ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT

The Enugu State Government through the Ministry of Budget and Planning held a one day Citizens' Engagement on 2025 Budget and Dissemination of 2023 Citizens Accountability Report on 19th day of November, 2024 at Nike Lake Resort Enugu.

The program started with the arrival and registration of participants at about 8:50am.

The Executive Governor of Enugu State, His Excellency Dr. Peter Ndubisi Mba ably represented by the Hon. Commissioner of Budget and Planning, Barr. Chris-Roberts Ozongwu who equally chaired the event.

The Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Budget and Planning Mrs. Clara Nwakaego Eze reiterated the reason for the gathering while specifying how happy people are about the good works of the Governor in the state. In her words, "we are here to tell the government what we want and encourage the government to do more".

Also present at the event were Members of the State Council of Traditional Rulers led by, Christian Association of Nigeria (CAN), Enugu Chapter, Umu Ada Igbo Group, Civil Society Organizations

The Opening prayer was led by Very Rev Father Benjamin Eze at about 1:28pm while the breaking of Kolanut ceremony was officiated by HRH Igwe Okolo of Amoji Nike who asked God to protect the Governor and give him long life and intellectual ability to carry on with his good works in Enugu State.

The event was declared open by the Executive Governor ably represented by the Hon. Commissioner for Budget and Planning, Barr.Chris - Roberts Ozongwu.

In his welcome address, the Hon. Commissioner for Budget and Planning, Barr.Chris - Roberts Ozongwu commended the Governor for his effortless and transparent leadership and his offer of commitment to good judgement and service delivery to Ndi Enugu.

He said that the forum is always to ensure participatory budget process and to gather the needs and priorities of different communities so that resources could be allocated accordingly, which in turn will enhance the greater public access to information about state government activities, facilities and ensure that all voices can be heard through this fair approach.

According to him, the government of Enugu State led by his Excellency Dr. Peter Mba is constantly encouraging the citizens' participation in decisions and implementation of government policies.

In his words, "This exercise, citizens' participation is a mechanism of guiding and has been characterized as necessary to ensure a good relationship between the government and the general public; quality service and quality implementation."

The Hon.Commissioner pointed out that everyone one in Enugu sees the projects being implemented in the State by the Governor who has stayed in the office for only 1 year and 6 months and has turned Enugu State into something beautiful and also promised the citizens that more is coming.

#### Good Will Messages

The Very Rev Father Benjamin Eze who represented the Faith-Based Organizations in delivering his goodwill message recognized the efforts of his Excellency Barr. Peter Ndubisi Mba who is filled with the capacity to do good and allowing citizens to be part of government by utilizing the options of common men.

He extended gratitude to his Excellency for being himself and doing what he knows how to do best while also wishing that God will continue to use him to direct the affairs of the State.

"I am happy that we are all here to discuss about the State's budget to make input and I appreciate His Excellency Barr. Peter Mba on his various talk and do projects in the State", expressed The Chairman Enugu State Traditional Rulers;

HRH Igwe Emmanuel Ugwu while delivering his good will message. The traditional father added that the members of the traditional council

are all proud that the Governor is fulfilling the promises he made with actions resulting in projects in education, health, transport sectors and overall in infrastructural developments in the state.

Speaking also was the Executive Director Civil Society Organizations, Dr. Cosmas Ohaka who added that participants have gathered to listen to the Hon. Commissioner and the Ministry and also make contributions in 2025 budget of Enugu State.

On behalf of the women, Umuada Igbo Group, Mrs Ekedigwe Ndidiamaka Juliet expressed appreciation to the Governor on his good works in the State. She stated that she is so happy to see him start his projects from where his predecessors stopped. Speaking further, she expressed hope that at the end of this tenure Enugu State will be a tourist haven.

The Chairman of the Trade Union Congress, Comrade Ben Asogwa also keyed in to the good will messages saying "Our Governor is doing well. We take time to praise people that are doing well so as to sustain more energy and know they are getting it right. Our Excellency the Governor hit the ground running immediately he came into office. The level of project he has on ground is still a surprise to so many people and we believe with this budget of 2025, it will ensure that there would not be any abandoned project because he has rescued projects that were abandoned for years in Enugu. As labour leaders we take time to say well-done to whoever that is doing well. We believe seriously in this government and hoping that this budget will move us forward and from our contributions in this program, the Governor will know what the citizens want for a better tomorrow as we hope for 2025 to be better than this year".

His Nigera Labour Congress counterpart, Barr. Fabian Nwigbo in his own speech appreciated the workaholic Governor calling him a promise keeping governor with a difference. He reiterated that His Excellency approved a minimum wage of N80,000 for civil servants in the state exceeding the national minimum wage of N70, 000. According to him, this speaks a lot about his good intentions in Enugu State and the workers are happy with his performance. He equally expressed happiness over the invitation happy to make contributions in the preparation of the year 2025 budget for his Excellency to know what the people really want and also appreciated the Ministry of Budget and Planning for organizing the engagement session.

Chairman Youth Leader PDP Enugu West, Ejike Ilo Kasie started by expressing gratitude following the inclusion of the Youth contributions on last year in the 2024 budget. He thanked the Hon. Commissioner for Budget and Planning showing that the gathering is not a joke. He added that the whole developmental project going in the state is for the youth, women and children adding that all the projects going on in our various autonomous communities and our various wards.

The Chairman Joint National Association of Persons with Disabilities, Enugu State Chapter, Comrade Onyebuchi Mba spoke on behalf of the association, thanking the Governor His Excellency Dr Peter Mba because he has changed a lot in the disability community. According to him, in education sector, His Excellency has reactivated the State inclusive education policy with the committee set up currently to look into the policy and develop it in such a way that it will be inclusive with the recommendations and most importantly those with disabilities are officially written to, invited and requested to nominate who represents them in that committee. He announced that

His Excellency increased the monthly subvention of Special Education Center in Oji River from #750,000 to #1.5 million currently and also ordered materials like bed and some other things he had approved to ensure that the school hostels have the needed materials for persons living with disabilities.

President General of Town Unions, said that a lot of projects are going on in the rural areas and that they are very grateful and appreciated His Excellency Dr Peter Mba for all his good works.

#### 2023 Budget Performance

The Implementation of the 2023 Revised budget was analyzed by the Chairman, Civil Society Organization, Barr. Cromwell Chibuzor. According to him, the 2023 budget originally was #166 billion for the 2023 fiscal year, but when Governor Mba came on board, the inflation gave rise to a supplementary budget of 2023 about #58 billion, making it a total of #224.7 billion. The revenue outcome of the State showed a budget size of #172.7 billion and an actual #220.6 billion. The State's expenditure profile showed #224.7 billion and actual #179.7 billion, with a performance rate of 80% for all standards.

#### 2024 Budget Performance

Hon. Commissioner for Budget and Planning, Barr. Chris-Roberts Ozongwu, presented the 2024 budget performance report. According to him, the State has over 1,000 ongoing projects, with a capital budget of #414 billion and a current expenditure of #107 billion. The Commissioner highlighted some of the notable achievements of the 2024 budget, including the approval of #25,000 incentive to all civil servants to cushion the effect of fuel price increase and a follow-up approval of #80,000 new minimum wage with effect from October 2024.

Other notable achievements include the construction of integrated Model Smart Schools in 260 wards across 17 LGAs, construction of International Conference Center Enugu, construction of International Hospital, Rangers Avenue, Enugu,

revitalization of Hotel Presidential, Enugu, and construction of Owo-Ubahu-Ama Nkanu-Neke Ikem Road, among others. The Commissioner emphasized that these achievements demonstrate the government's commitment to transforming the state and improving the lives of its citizens.

#### Ease of Doing Business Reforms in the State

The Managing Director Enugu State Investment Development Authority, Dr. Sam Ogbu-Nwobodo, in his speech, referred to Enugu State as the right economic hub in Nigeria that is attracting both local and foreign investment due to its strategic reforms aimed at improving the Ease of Doing Business (EODB) in the State. According to him, the State government led by His Excellency Dr. Peter Ndubisi Mba, with his progressive administration, is committed to creating an enabling environment to support entrepreneurs through investment. He said that Enugu State's economic indicators are promising, with remarkable growth in small and medium scale enterprises and increased capital investment from both local and international investors, involving investors' confidence in the management of Enugu State economy by the present administration.

Dr. Ogbu-Nwobodo further stated that it was through government efforts that diverse business opportunities were established. He also said that when the Governor came into office, he signed the Executive Order NO 3, which gave rise to economic growth through investment based on Ease of Doing Business, transparency, creditability, and accountability. Again, he said that different MDAs have been mandated, especially the business enabling MDAs, to create and publish their Service Level Agreement so as to avoid hidden charges or unclear regulatory processes.

In his words, "As a result, today, I am bold to stand before you to reaffirm this administrative commitment to fostering a business-friendly environment where every entrepreneur, both local and foreign, can thrive with confidence and creditability." He further said that he has heard about the numerous projects and he is on the side of receiving moribund industries and State enterprises. And therefore, he believed that the State is missing one of the key legacies of its founding fathers, which is the Niger Gas Plant in Emene, and he went further to say, in assurance, that the Plant will become operational by the end of January 2025.

According to him, a thriving business environment is a foundation for creating jobs, generating wealth, and improving the general quality of life of the people. Many persons from different organizations made input in the budgetary processes and pleaded to have an increased budget allocation in different sectors like Water Resources, construction of roads, Electricity, Education, Health Care, etc.

In closing remarks, HRH Ikechukwu Asadu Ogadagidi appreciated everyone that made it to the engagement. In his words "we the Royal Fathers are very happy for finding time to make positive input in our State and I PRAY that God will bless everyone abundantly". He commended everyone from different organizations and pleaded with the Commissioner to remember them for proper engagement in 2025 budget. He therefore urged all to be in peace and unity so as to continue moving forward. The Very Rev. Father Benjamin Eze said the closing prayer at about 3:13 pm.

#### CITIZENS INPUTS

1. Name: Engr. Eusebius U. Oyigbo (PG Amozalla Affa Udi North)

I plead with the Governor Peter Mba to construct Eke- Egede Affa Akpakwume- Aku Road so as to reduce kidnapping and also travellers from Abuja to Anambra will equally use this road instead of going through Opi to 9th miles.

Again Amozalla Affa and all the communities have no access to water and also we need a Police station in Affa.

 Name: Comrade Barr. Fabian Nwigbo (Chairman Nigeria Labour Congress Enugu State Council). I request for housing for workers of Enugu State. Secondly, construction of Agu Ukehe road that runs from Umunko in Igbo Etiti LGA through Agu Ukehe to Ugwogo Nike.

Thirdly, we plead for the completion of the NLC Secretariat at N01 works road GRA Enugu.

Finally, revitalization of Ohebedim Aluminium Industry.

3. Name: Ozo Ejike Ilo Tasie (PDP Zonal Youth Leader Enugu West).

I appreciate the Governor Peter Mba and I'm pleading that work should commence at Umuabi- Ehuhe Achi- Court Old Portharcourt road so as to reduce the suffering of our people to the minimum.

4. Name: Comrade Rose Ugwu (Chairperson NLC Women Committee)

I plead with His Excellency Barr Peter Mba to bring Army or Police Barracks in Uzo-Uwani LGA to enable us to go to farm without fear.

Again Nkpolugu Community needs water.

5. Name: Uzor Ugonna Kingsley (Executive Director Red Foundation).

We need budgetary allocation for counterpart founding of Social Development activities in Enugu State for local and international NPOs and NGOs.

6. Name: Anayo Ruth Oluchi (CSO Member)

I plead with the Governor Peter Mba to establish a "Talent Development Fund". Allocate some millions in animal bases for children's talent development programs, in various LGAs to identify gifted children.

Establish children's Art and Craft worshippers.

Construct multi purpose talent centers in each LGA.

 Name: Comrade Dr. Ezekiel Omeh (Chairman Joint Public Service Negotiating Council JNC Enugu State).

Establishment of independent power project through Public Private Partnership (PPP) to encourage competition in energy provision and services to the State.

Construction of Umuida- Unadu Akpanya road that is now cut off by erosion.

Palm wine bottling and preservation company to be sited at Umuida, Enugu Ezike where Palm wine is massively produced.

I plead with the government also to subsidize land registration for civil servants that are able to acquire land for personal housing project.

8. Name: Dr. Oraedu Nnem Juliet (NLC Enugu State).

We plead with His Excellency to include Agbudu Udi in the ongoing Smart School Project and Smart Health Project in Agbudu Udi.

Again water project should also be considered since we have a by-pass road connecting Udi to Oji River way. Also we need a road network in Agbudu Udi.

9. Global Missions International (GLOMINT)

We plead with the Governor Peter Mba to provide shelter for older people, and rehabilitate those dilapidated hospital halls.

Secondly, provision of shelter to the violated in a secluded area in Enugu State.

## 10.Sonia Okonkwo (CSO/OGP Partner)

The adjourning streets after Idaw River and Ikirike is terrible. All the roads/streets linking One Day road like Oliver Agbo and Co are impassable as only Meniru, Mount is good.

## 11. Name: Cosmas Ohaka (Researcher, Development Consultant)

The Alulu road at the foot of "T" Junction Flyover and a good bypass to link Trans Ekulu and Enugu East LGA quarters is in a terrible condition. The community has no school, hospital or any other government facility. Constructing this road will give the residents a sense of belonging.

#### 12. Name: Engr. Ralph Ndigwe.

In light of the recent autonomy granted to Local Governments, I propose that Enugu State initiate the construction of multi-level flats designed for workers with a requirement to complete at least one such project every three years during their tenure.

#### 13. Ezemal Sylvester PG

I plead with the government to help us construct the road that lead to Itchi-agu community Igboeze South. Again we don't have electricity supply in my community since five years ago and also there is no commissioned secondary school in Itchi Agu community. Government please come to our rescue.

#### 14. Name: Ozoihu Chimma Jane (Women Organization)

I want to make an appeal that the government should provide personal computers or laptops to teachers in the school system as we all know that we are in the computer age and a lot of informations are provided in the Internet. This will help the teachers to be fully equipped with knowledge in their individual fields and for outermost productivity in the education sector.

Also speaking on behalf of my community Umumba Ndi Uno Ezeagu along Enugu/Onitsha expressway, my community is having the issue of water scarcity. I therefore appeal that the government in 2025 budget should come to our aid.

#### 15. Name: John O. Aneke PG

There is no electricity in my community Obeleagu Umana and our Community Secondary School is in a dilapidated state since its inception over 20 years ago. Government please help us.

#### 16. Name: Comrade Peter Nwaiwu

Please government should consider the construction of the of Nkwubor Ugwuomu Road to join the Orie Emene road. This road is so important as it inhabits a lot of farmers and farm produce of which of this access is given, the suffering of the farmers bringing their produce to the market will be reduced and the exorbitant prices on the locally produced goods.

### 17.Name: Chiamaka (JONAPWD)

Disability Commission for Enugu State persons with disabilities.

Budget line for Enugu State persons with disabilities.

Increase in subvention for Oji River Special Education Center, school of the deaf Oji and rehab center Emene.

Economic empowerment of Persons with disabilities

Assistive technology for persons with disabilities.

18. Name: Okoroafor Blessing Nkechi (JONAPWD)

The transport system scheme of the State should be made accessible for persons with disabilities in Enugu State.

19. Name: Comrade Onyebuchi Mba (Chairman JONAPWD Enugu Chapter)

I want to request for a specially designed Housing Scheme targeted at persons with disabilities because there are few of us into the State civil service as civil servants, we plead with the government to establish a house for low income earners.

Secondly, I request that 2025 budget should capture Health Insurance Scheme for persons with disabilities because a whole lot of us cannot afford hospital requirements for treatment.

Finally across the 17 LGAs of the State, all the public infrastructures we are witnessing now, let there be total inclusivity, while we build our roads build it in such a way that a person on a wheelchair will see a space to go through, and also a blind person can navigate his or her way.

20. Name: Ichie Obinwanne (Coordinating PG for PGs Udi LGA)

Enact a law specifying roles of Igwe and President Generals.

Rehabilitation of boreholes in communities, this is because water is the major problem of rural dwellers in Enugu State.

Improve the welfare of pensioners- pay monthly pension regularly, increase the pension to match new minimum wage.

Continue to improve security in our State to allow our people to go to their farms and do other business affairs freely.

21.Name: Ugwu Gabriel

Firstly, Edem road in Nsukka should be considered for construction.

Secondly, as a civil servant, I suggest that houses for Civil servants are very necessary as it will reduce the economic burden on the staff of Enugu State.

Finally, development of farm infrastructure at farm settlement in Agu-Amagu Akpa Edem as this will provide ground for food security if the potential of this area is put into consideration.

22. Name: Ude Chijioke (Youth leader of Ngwo Asaa ward)

We plead on government to provide water for the people of Ngwo Asaa.

23.Name: Hon. Festus Ndubuisi (PG of Aguobu-Iwollo Autonomous Community)
We want our Secondary School Laboratory equipped. The school is an eye saw, no nothing and the building is dilapidated.

24.Name: Mr Obinna Omerecheta (Youth Leader Agbadala Achi- Community Oji River)

I request that the government should please provide access road to our farm lands, and also silos and storage industries for the future of Ndi Enugu.

Provision of housing units for Enugu State workers considering primary school teachers.

Training of youth in Palm plantation because it is a very lucrative business.

Setting out schemes for youths to access loans for quality development and engage them with business.

### 25. Name: Comrade Benneth Asogwa (TUC Chairman)

I humbly request for further provision in the budget of 2025 to expand the water reticulation to other areas of Enugu.

It is the wish of workers for Interest Free Loan Program to be provided for workers who have need for loan will have this as an alternative considering the high interest rate of loans in commercial banks.

May I humbly request for government to complete the Aku- Leija Nsukka Road which was constructed by Federal government and it just remain about 3 kilometers to join the road to Nsukka urban.

On behalf of Trade Union Congress (TUC), Enugu State Council and the entire workers, I hereby request for the inclusion of the completion of TUC State Secretariat building located at the Daily Star Office behind First Bank Zik Avenue.

### 26. Name: Prince Oliver Okozor (PG PRO Enugu State PG's)

We commend the government of Enugu State for the minimum wage adoption and implementation to the Civil Servants of the State. Please help to include the enhancement of the President General's stipend from #30,000 to #80,000 since we buy in the same market and the tedious work we undergo in our various communities.

27.Name: Ikenna Ogbodo (PG Enugu Autonomous Community, Ndiagu Akpugo in Nkanu- West LGA)

I plead with the government that Enugu Autonomous Community caved out from Ugwuafor Autonomous Community need the help of the government in the area of road construction. We have no road at all. Our people are suffering so much especially during the rainy season. And again we have no Primary and Secondary Schools at all. Please government should come to our help.

28. Name: Ebuka Anichukwu (JONAPWD)

Having known that housing is one of the difficulties we as persons with disabilities are facing in the State, let the payment of the low income Housing Scheme be deducted from the salary monthly.

29.Name: Hon. Festus Ndubuisi (PG Aguobu Iwollo Autonomous Community)

The government should kindly come to our aid in the rehabilitation of our Primary and Secondary School buildings in our community.

30.Name: Barr. Dorothy Oleka (Nwanyi bu Ife Development and Resource Foundation Awgu LGA).

We plead with the government to specifically allocate huge budget to enable the school of Nursing and Midwifery Awgu to meet its emerging demands as a result of the current intake of prospective nurses and midwives.

They require lecture halls and equipments to facilitate training.

Accommodation/Hostels and water to ease the study processes for our children.

Secondly, government should allocate some resources in the Ministry of Health so as to look into the Emergency Unit in Parklane hospital Enugu.

31. Name: Ugwuanyi John (PG of the Community).

Nkalagu-Obukpa Community is one of the towns in Igboeze South with no road and our people are mainly farmers. To transport their farm products to urban areas is very difficult. I plead with the government to help us construct our roads.

32.Name: Benneth Obinna Ugwu (Akirinja Rehabilitation Center owned by Enugu Diocesan Therapeutic Center).

We plead that the government get involved in partnering with us to establish more rehab centers to address mental illness and substance abuse in the State, that is treating clients to help them get back into the State workforce and begin to contribute to the economic strength of the State.

#### 33.Name: Ambassador Amaka Nweke (CSO)

I request that an increased budget allocation in the water sector should be reflected on the 2025 budget because water issue is not a child's play so we are hopeful that more allocations will be made in the area of water and sanitation to nail the issue of water scarcity forever in Enugu State. WATER IS LIFE.

Finally, we want to also advocate for an increase in budget for the Ministry of Children, Gender and Social Development because children and women are very key sector to look into and also to encourage the Ministry to be able to deliver a good service delivery to the people. We know the issue of gender based violence and how women are being abused, they need job and some of them need rehabilitation and also to get their mental health stable because of the abuse they face everyday. We will be glad if the government will increase their budget in this regard.

34. Name: Aliozo Ikenna (PG of Aguobu-Iwollo Autonomous Community)

I want the government to allocate more money to Enugu State polytechnic so that it will survive. This same community is hosting the coal mining site. There is no security and no adequate road for transportation in the Iwollo community and I am pleading with the government to do something about it in this 2025 budget.

35. Name: Ozo Prince Uche Ayalogu representing HRH Igwe IOU Ayalogu.

I plead with the government to have an arrangement where people who want to enter into agriculture on their own can have a resource center were they can get information to really get started in the area they are interested. This is because it will empower creation of employment where people will now be in charge of their own private enterprises there by creating different companies in the State as this will help to attract investors.

36. Name: Ede Romanus (PG of Eziokwe Amokwe Amuri Community)

I plead with the government to provide a land for agriculture in my community.

Secondly, in Amuri it seems like a dejected community because there is no road since I was born till now. We are pleading with the government to remember us and help to fix our community.
